BCCI ACCREDITATION GUIDELINES FOR ELECTRONIC MEDIA

The accreditation passes could be issued at the media-centre at the venues themselves.

- Only one Sports journalist recommended by the Editor of a Print Media (National as well as Regional) publication will be given accreditation at a venue.
- Only one journalist representing a recognized News Agency will be given accreditation at a venue.
- Only one photographer per Print Media publication or News Agency will be given accreditation at a venue.
- Only one pair (journalist + cameraman) representing an Electronic Media Group will be given accreditation.
- Only one card to be issued for a photographer representing a print media publication (national as well as regional).
- ❖ Applications of websites for accreditation will not be entertained.
- Every application for accreditation will have to be accompanied by two photographs.
- ❖ Every application will have to be accompanied by a covering letter signed by the editor of the concerned publication / channel.
- ❖ The accreditation cards will have to be collected in person, at the venue of the first match he / she is attending.
- ❖ All journalists holding accreditations will have to meet the Media Managers at the match venues a day before the game to collect their match-passes.
- ❖ THEY WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE VENUES ONLY IF THEY HAVE THEIR ACCREDITATION CARD AS WELL AS A MATCH-PASS.
- ❖ All photographers will have to sign an undertaking to the effect that the pictures taken during the match / matches will not be utilized for commercial purposes.
