New Delhi: January 15, 2009 — A delegation of the News Broadcasters Association (NBA) led by its President, Mr. G. Krishnan, called on Mrs. Sonia Gandhi, Chairperson, UPA, today. Mrs. Gandhi assured the delegation that she firmly believed that the media should be free and there should be no restrictions imposed on it. She stated that there would be no such action taken by the government, which would be detrimental to the working of a free media.
